The Echoes Harrison River Retreat



GET AWAY FROM IT ALL at the Echoes at Harrison Hot Springs in BC. This unique, off-grid getaway was designed with sustainability in mind, without sacrificing creature comforts.

Each of the retreat's three red cedar cabins are equipped with a bathroom, fireplace and either a king-size or two double beds. The bathrooms are furnished with a composting toilet, eco-friendly soaps, a hot water shower, and luxurious towels and robes. Solar panels provide power for each cabin.

The property includes half a mile of water-front trails, a huge dock, firepit, a wood-fired hot tub and heated cookhouse where dinner is served, home-cooked with fresh, local ingredients. Proprietors Susan and Clint also offer guided fishing and hunting, boat tours, on-site massage services and more.

In keeping with the remote feel of the retreat, guests park in Harrison Hot Springs, and are whisked away to their cabin in a covered, heated boat. The 10-minute boat ride adds to the sense of seclusion of this special spot, but isn't too long if you need to get back in a hurry.
